Sporting Clays Clay Target Field

The sporting clays clay target shooting range was constructed in conjunction with the new Canaan Valley Tube Park and ski area updates. The winter recreation updates were opened the winter of 2012/2013.

Many of the infrastructure costs for the sporting clays - the site work, grading, electrical work - were included and absorbed as part of that development. The Tube Park building known as the “warming hut” also serves as the point of sale for the range, as well as secured equipment storage.

Project costs

The cost of the trap building, observation shelter, five shooting stations, and wobble clay trap machine was approximately \$82,000.

Seeding and landscaping will continue as the facility comes online.

Key players in the Sporting Clays project

The shooting range was engineered by Chapman Technical Group of St. Albans, and constructed by Wiseman Construction of Charleston. Engineering staff with the State Park System, the state park and resort management employees were also involved in development of this project and facility.
