On August 6, Governor Jim Justice announced West Virginia would open its 36th state park, Summersville Lake State Park. As the newest park to open in more than 30 years, this 177-acre outdoor oasis sits on the northern shore of the state's largest lake in Nicholas County and will be transformed into a premiere outdoor adventure park in one of West Virginia's most iconic spots. The park currently features hiking and biking trails, a picnic area, and an Almost Heaven swing, with more access to outdoor recreation opening in the coming months.
