



## KANAWHA STATE FOREST

**Monday, March 17th** Join Naturalist Jess Blalock on a hike on the Alligator Rock and Teaberry Rock Loop starting at 10a (moderate difficulty, steep portions with rocks and exposed roots). Meet at the Nature Center! From 12p-4p, stop by our outdoor tables behind the Nature Center to speak with a Naturalist, pick up a map, and see selected items from our collection (weather permitting). Not sure what it was that you photographed? Maybe we can help you identify it!

**Tuesday, March 18th** Join Naturalist Jess Blalock for a hike on the CCC Snipe Trail to look for our early Spring ephemerals and wildflowers at 10a (easy). Meet at the Nature Center! From 12p-4p, stop by our outdoor tables behind the Nature Center to speak with a Naturalist.

**Wednesday, March 19th** Talk with Naturalist Tiffany Jarrett at the Nature Center from 8a-1p! Bring your questions about the wildlife and trees that call our forest home!

**Thursday, March 20th** Meet Naturalists Tiffany Jarrett and Jess Blalock behind the Nature Center to get your questions about KSF answered! Take an interpretive walk through the KSF Arboretum with Tiffany Jarrett at 1p! (Weather permitting; Arboretum Walk is rated “easy” and suitable for all ages.)

**Friday, March 21st** Join Naturalist Tiffany Jarrett at the Nature Center to make pinecone bird feeders and learn about native birds in the forest! Weather permitting, we’ll make them outside!

**Saturday, March 22nd** Join Naturalist Tiffany Jarrett at 1p for an interpretive walk and Spring Watch along the Spotted Salamander Trail! Meet at the Spotted Salamander Trail and bring your cameras! Rated easy, suitable for all ages!

**Sunday, March 23rd** Join Naturalist Tiffany Jarrett at 1p at Shelter 4 to Search A Stream! Nets provided (limited number). Wear water clothes and shoes, in case we get wet. We’ll be looking for things that you can find in Davis Creek

**Monday, March 24th** Join Naturalist Jess Blalock at 10a for a hike on Teaberry Rock and Middle Ridge! We’ll meet at the Nature Center. We will be taking Teaberry Rock up to Middle Ridge Road and descending on Middle Ridge 1A, which will take us to the entrance of Kanawha State Forest. We will take Davis Creek Trail back to the Nature Center. This hike is rated moderate-difficult for steep portions. At 1p, stop by the outdoor tables (weather permitting) to pick up a map, speak with a Naturalist, and see selected items from our collection!
