Permit is good for one year from the date of approval. Cache permits <u>must be</u> renewed on a yearly basis. When the permit expires, cache owners may apply to renew the cache permit for the original location, subject to review and approval by the area superintendent to ensure that a cache does not create a negative environmental impact.

We recommend that you monitor this cache on a quarterly basis, and that you maintain it to be family friendly. This means the cache should contain no food, alcohol, firearms, drugs, dangerous items or adult items.

We also request that you direct people seeking your cache to follow established trails most of the way to your cache. We discourage off-trail hiking as it negatively impacts the environment.
