

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS PINNACLE ROCK STATE PARK

CEMETERY TRAIL | M | 1.3 MI ONE WAY

BLAZE COLOR

TRAIL RATING | | NOT A LOOP TRAIL

This trail branches off Homestead Trail near the picnic area and ends at County Road 52/6 near Jerry Lewis Lake.

TURKEY ROCK TRAIL | 🕅 | 1.5 MI

BLAZE COLOR

TRAIL RATING

Begin at Homestead Trail near the picnic area. Follow Homestead past the intersection of Cemetery Trail, then make a right onto the unimproved road that doubles as Turkey Rock Trail. The trail turns to single track and forms a loop past a towering rock formation known as Turkey Rock before it connects to Beaver Pond Trail. At Beaver Pond Trail, make a left back to Homestead, passing an old home site, to complete the loop.

BEAVER POND TRAIL | 120 | 0.7 MI ONE WAY

BLAZE

TRAIL RATING | | NOT A LOOP TRAIL

This trail runs from County Road 52/6 at Jimmy Lewis Lake back toward Pinnacle Rock, merging with Turkey Rock Trail and Homestead Trail, which ends at the picnic area.

ACORN RIDGE TRAIL | M | 1 MI ONE WAY

BLAZE COLOR



This trail begins at County Road 2/6 at Jimmy Lewis Lake toward Pinnacle Rock, where it connects to Homestead Trail. Make a left on Homestead to emerge at the picnic area, or turn right on Homestead to return to Jimmy Lewis Lake.

HOMESTEAD TRAIL | 1.2 MI ONE WAY

BLAZE



Homestead Trail runs from County Road 52/6 at Jimmy Lewis Lake toward Pinnacle Rock, connecting with Acorn Ridge Trail, Turkey Rock Trail and Cemetery Trail before emerging at the picnic area.

FALLING ROCK TRAIL | M | 800 FT ONE WAY

TRAIL RATING | | | NOT A LOOP TRAIL

Falling Rock Trail is an out and back trail, which leads under the massive Pinnacle Rock.

LAKEVIEW TRAIL | M | 0.7 MI ONE WAY

BLAZE COLOR

TRAIL RATING | | NOT A LOOP TRAIL

This trail begins near the parking area at Jimmy Lewis Lake and runs the length of the lake, ending at County Road 52/6.

OVERLOOK TRAIL | M | 400 FT ONE WAY

TRAIL RATING | • | NOT A LOOP TRAIL

Overlook Trail is an out and back trail with stone steps that leads up near the top of Pinnacle Rock to an overlook deck.

TRAIL RATINGS



EASIEST

Smooth graded trial with improved surfaces, few obstacles and gentle grades.



EASIER

Gentle off road trail with typical obstacles including gravel, loose rocks, sticks, bridges, narrow tread and trees.



INTERMEDIATE

Challenging trail with steep slopes, varying obstacles, rocks, significant grates and narrow tread.



FXPFR1

Steep grades, loose surfaces, natural and man made obstacles, elevated features, berms, jumps, very narrow tread.



VERY DIFFICULT

Advanced riding skills required, Trails may not be continuously ride able or walkable and air time may be required. From scenic vistas to beautiful overlooks, hiking trails at West Virginia's state parks and forests lead to breathtaking mountain scenery. Along the way create lasting memories but remember to leave no trace behind in Almost Heaven.
