Monday, December 8

1PM: Skins and Skulls. You can learn a lot about wildlife by examining the things they leave behind! All about some of the more commonly encountered critters in the forest.

3PM: Poison vs Venom. Is there a difference between the two? We'll talk about both, and how they can be encountered in the wild. **(25 Mins) *YPP**
