February 2 through February 15, 2026

All winter park activities will meet at the Lodge area unless otherwise specified.

Wednesday, February 4

10AM: Tygart Lake History Walk. Meet at the Dam Parking Lot at the Almost Heaven Swing. This walk is about a 1.5-mile loop with some hilly terrain. All about the story of Tygart Lake and Dam. **(90 Mins) *YPP**

Thursday, February 5

11AM: Poison vs. Venom: What's the Difference? Are these things the same? Why are they different? Let's go over the basics, including safely dealing with both. **Meet at the Lodge Lobby area. (25 Mins) *YPP**

Friday, February 6
