Join Liz Moss of WVSU Extension Service at the Nature Center to learn how to identify trees in Winter! We will begin inside with a lecture and specimens. Participants should prepare for light

hiking on moderate terrain for the second half of the workshop. We will cover basic Winter tree ID clues - leaf scar arrangement, twigs, buds, lenticels, bud scales, etc. - and learn to use a dichotomous key. Go home armed with some confidence, a pocket tree ID guide, and a hand lens!
