March 16 through March 29, 2026

All winter park activities will meet at the Lodge area unless otherwise specified.

Wednesday, March 18

11AM: Skins and Skulls. You can learn a lot about the critters of the forest by some of the things they have left behind. What can be found out in the woods? Let's find out! **(30 Mins)**

Thursday, March 19

10AM: Lake Trail Hike. Departing from the Nature Center lot. Join Park Naturalist Jacob for a short walk to the lake and back. We'll talk about the history of the area, and some of the local trees and animal life. Hike is approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile total. **(45 Mins)**

Friday, March 20

3PM-5PM: Meet a Naturalist. Park Naturalist Jacob will be on-hand at the Lodge lobby area to meet you and answer any burning questions you might have about wildlife or the park.

10AM: The Green Day Hike. Join us in welcoming back this springtime State Parks tradition! We meet at the Nature Center lot for a hike on the Ridge Trail to welcome in Spring. Hike is approximately 1.5 miles in length and will include some steep terrain. Be sure to wear good shoes and bring water. All participants will receive a 'Green Day Hike' patch. No charge, and dogs are always welcome on-leash.
