Come and visit the Cass Company Store and Shays Restaurant! Park naturalist is staffed seasonally to provide a variety of interpretive, educational, and recreational programs on the Park's natural and cultural history. The Company Store is open 7 days a week.

April 28, 2026

5:00PM WV White Butterfly Showcase Meet at the Company Store. The WV white butterfly is a small, rare, woodland butterfly found in Appalachian forests. Learn the plants the butterfly needs as well as the invasive garlic mustard that is causing their declines. One of the best ways to control garlic mustard is pulling up by hand, so if you're willing, we will put you to work on some of that.

April 29, 2026

5:00PM WV State Bird Special Meet at the Company Store. The northern cardinal is WV's State Bird. Take a hike around Cass to find these birds and learn more about them.

April 30, 2026

5:00PM Spring Wildflowers Meet at the Company Store. Take a hike around the Park to see what spring wildflowers are blooming in Cass.

May 1, 2026

5:00PM Invasive Species Roundup Meet at the Company Store. Take a walk around the Park and learn to identify common non-native invasive plant species.

May 2, 2026

5:00PM Vultures Meet at the Company Store. Take a walk around the Park to learn about vultures.

May 5, 2026

5:00PM Mayfly Monday Meet at the Company Store. Learn about common mayflies in WV, their lifecycle, and how to use this knowledge in fly fishing.

5:00PM Garlic Mustard Control - Learn some interesting facts about garlic mustard, a common invasive plant that has implications for conservation in WV.
