9:30am. – “Moonshine Trail Hike” – Meet at the trail head for this 3.25 – mile hike. This is a single track trail with some substantial climbs. (JNR) B.S.

1:30pm. – “Twist Through Time” – Head to the breezeway outside of the Nature Center to learn about Yucca and its many uses. Before duct tape there was yucca!! 3:00pm. – “I’m Likin Lichen” – West Virginia has more than 250 known species of lichens. West Virginia’s forest supports a wide variety of lichens because of the state’s mix of mountains, old growth, sandstone cliffs, wetlands and changing elevation. We will discuss the three most common that you are surely going to see if out on the trails. (JNR) T.C

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hike. This is the perfect trail to see an area reverting back to a forest. Stay vigilant as this trail holds a lot of cool critters such as deer, turkey, black bear, rabbits, warblers, eastern bluebirds and whitetail deer. (JNR) N.E

2:00pm. – “WV Wild Turkeys” – Wild turkeys are the largest ground feeding bird in North America and that in itself is pretty cool! Head to the Nature Center to learn about this species, we will discuss their diet, biology, habitat, language they speak and so much more. (JNR) T.C

4:00pm. – 5:00pm. – “Roaming Ranger” – Do you have a burning question about the park? Maybe you want to know what is the Rangers favorite trail and why? Bugs will be roaming around the front lobby to answer any park related question you may have. Swing by and say hi! B.S
