Come and visit the Cass Company Store and Shays Restaurant! Park naturalist is staffed seasonally to provide a variety of interpretive, educational, and recreational programs on the Park's natural and cultural history. The Company Store is open 7 days a week.

August 27, 2026

10:00AM Cass History Tour Meet at the Company Store. Take a hike with the Naturalist to explore the old Cass Mill and some of the unique history of the town.

3:00PM The Cass Plant Atlas Meet at the Company Store. Join the Naturalist to work on the Cass Plant Atlas. We will take pictures and identify plants wildlife we can find on the park and add new species to the list of things that occur on the Park

August 28, 2026
